Let your child draw and tell you about their favorite book and ask why it is his/her favorite. Visit the library.	Have your child help you with "spring cleaning." Allow them to pack away their winter clothes.

Share a family story with your child. Ask your child to retell the story.	Cut out different shades of blue from a magazine. Glue onto a piece of paper.	Let your child "read" you a book. Have your child choose a blue colored item to wear for the day. Have them draw a self-portrait.	Color with your child objects you see at home using crayons or markers.
